Curious about watercolor but don't know where to begin? Get the basics, learn about materials, tools and techniques to start your

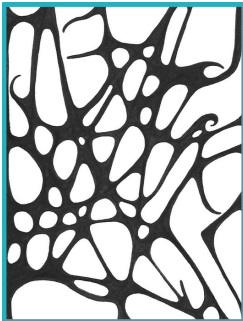
watercolor journey, as well as some fun recommendations for projects. All materials are included – if you have paints and want to bring them, feel free.

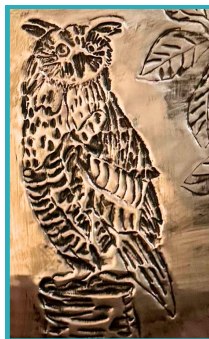


**Ceramic Ring Dishes**

shapes out of thin slabs of ceramic clay, finish the edges and decorate with some Elan Transfer under-glaze decal transfer images (including flowers, cats, and other imagery). Learn to layer the underglaze decals with underglazes if you want to add some color. Students will make up to 3 pieces that will be ready for pick up later.

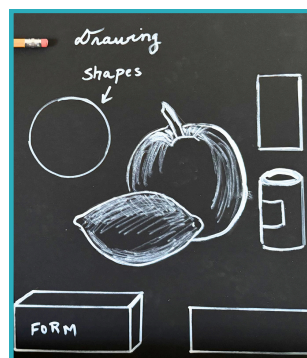


**Metal Embossing**

I'll help you decide which picture works the best, then it will be drawn, then traced onto the metal, and then ink will be applied. Wear clothing that you might get ink on.

Learn the basics of mosaics while working on a stepping stone that can be used in the

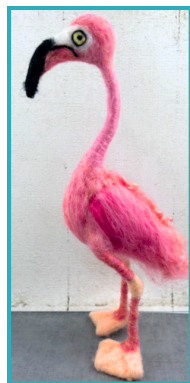

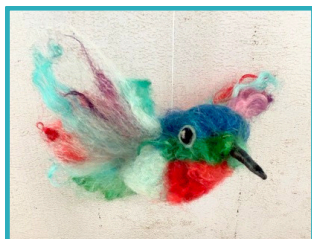


**Sarafina Style Needle Felted Flamingo**

Are you ready to bring in some bright, fun colors into your space? Come and learn how

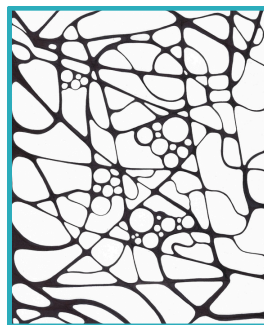
